




# Number Challenge Competition


We have all enjoyed celebrating Number Day recently, starting with an assembly and engaging in fun number-themed activities.


The children were given the task of creatively showing their favourite number.

This is her 3rd belt and she is on the great path to achieve a black belt in the future which is one of her biggest goals.


