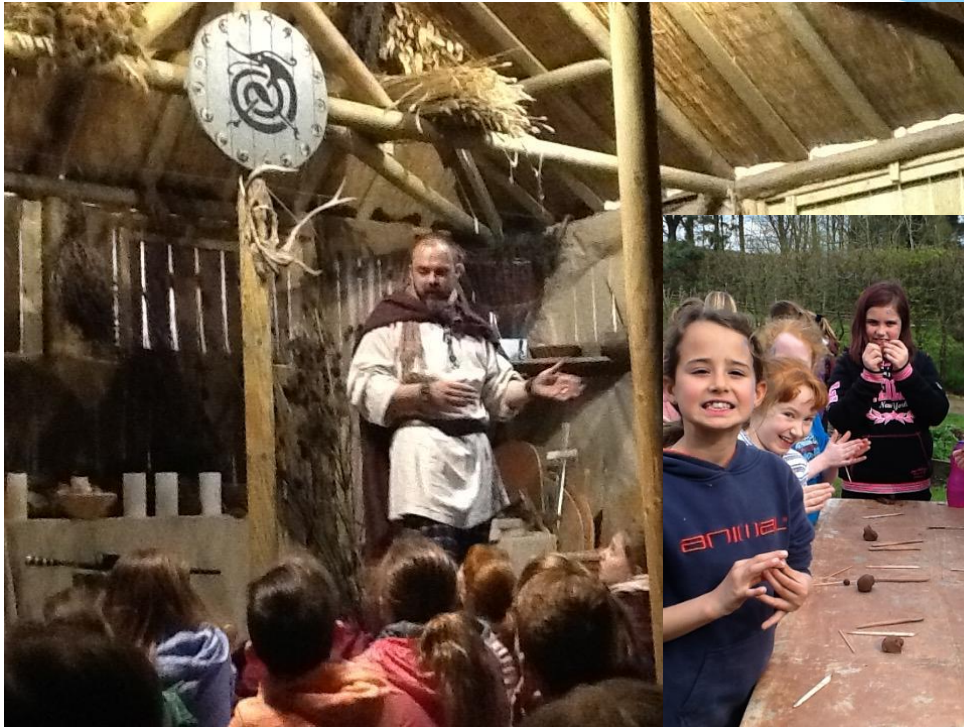

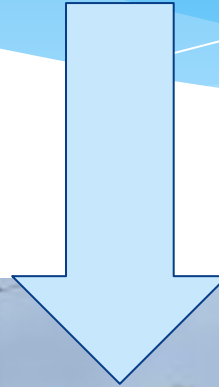

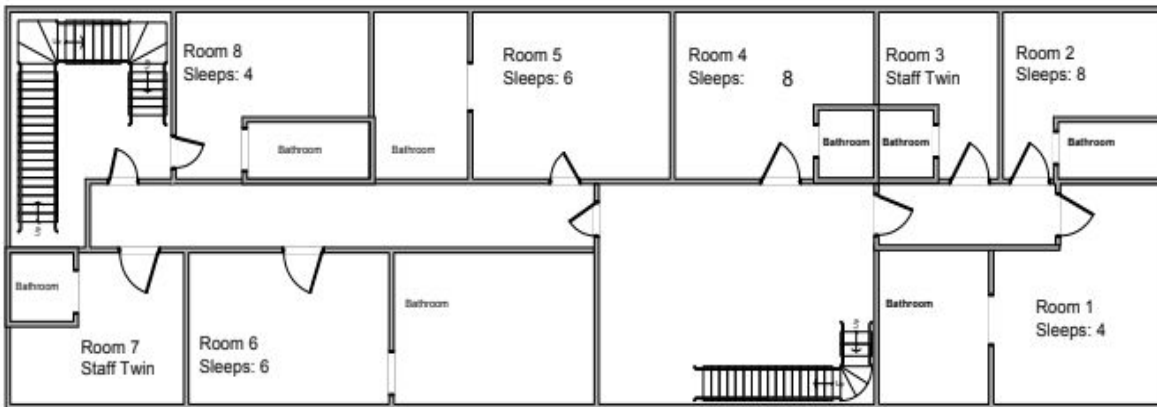


# Accommodation in The Court

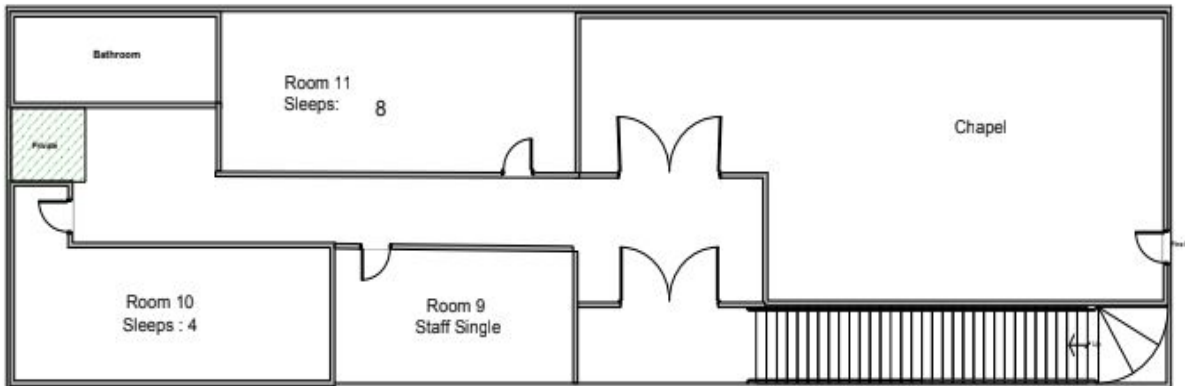
