

Headteacher Update

This week started with a whole school assembly focusing on the British Value of democracy and explaining what the U.K. Parliament is to the children ahead of Polling Day yesterday. Following a careful check of all the votes we have now got our first School Parliament in place. Further details below. I am always very proud to show visitors or prospective families around our wonderful school. Again, this week, I have received lots of positive comments about the children's behaviour and attitudes to learning which is great.

Today, we have had two assemblies, our first one the weekly celebration assembly and the second was a Remembrance Day assembly. Some children read poems, we sang a Remembrance song and I was very impressed with how respectful everyone was observing the two minutes silence. The children were then able to write a message on these which Ray then collected and displayed around Verwood.
