Headteacher Update 3rd November 2023

I hope you had a wonderful half-term break! It has been a joy to welcome the children back this week. We started off with a whole-school assembly to revisit our three school rules, British Values, and our core school values.

Across the school, the children have been fully engaged in their learning once again. Our Reception children have been busy creating fantastic firework pictures, making rockets, and delving into the world of numbers, with a special focus on the number 5. Year I has kicked off their new topic, 'Welcome to Verwood,' and had a fun time locating Verwood on a map. Meanwhile, Year 2 has been immersed in a variety of traditional tales and will soon focus in more depth on the story of The Three Little Pigs. Year 3 and 4 have continued their fascinating journey through Roman history, delving into column method subtraction.

Over the half-term break, work has commenced on the fencing around the school perimeter, and we're excited to announce that our outdoor Reception area has been extended, providing even more space for the children to explore and learn. I've included a couple of photos below for you to see the progress.

We have a bustling half-term ahead of us leading up to Christmas, with a host of exciting events and activities planned for the children. I want to ensure you have all the details well in advance. 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
